Jeffrey Venter is a Senior Principal of DVS.

Mr. Venter has over 37 years of security criteria and systems design experience in commercial, federal, cultural and high risk facilities. Mr. Venter has developed security designs for 20 Courthouses, including 10 Federal Courthouses, implementing the post-Oklahoma bombing GSA security criteria. He was the principal technical designer for the nationwide Federal Protective Service Mega-Center project which monitors over 9,000 federal buildings.

His project activities include development of threat and risk assessments and operational and technical security programs. Mr. Venter has displayed conceptualization and project management leadership over the design and engineering of electronic and physical security, fire protection, and life safety systems. He has overseen the development of product specifications responsive to architectural designs, finishes, and aesthetic vocabulary, and the provision of design and specification support to project architectural teams for forced entry, ballistic, explosive event, arson, and CBR protection.

Mr. Venter has provided consulting and design engineering for Data Centers, Critical Infrastructure Projects, Multi-Tenant Projects, Museums, Libraries, Universities, Judiciary, FPS, USMS and US Attorney Branches and coordinating with GSA.
